Main Duties:

- Build a relationship with all EIS employees/parents/students.
- Schedule the teaching and staff morning worship in the auditorium/library.
- Schedule and lead the prayer and morning thought at flag line-up for the High School Section.
- Conduct faculty and section morning worship as scheduled.
- Conduct classroom visitations. This includes morning worship and private prayer or counseling for EIS Faculty and Staff.
- Class guest speaker upon the teacher's request.
- In charge of chapel programs and weeks of prayer.
- Prepare & update the Spiritual Master Plan and submit it to the School Principal prior to the end of the school year.
- Conduct prayer groups, worship programs, and Bible study classes among students, parents, faculty, and staff.
- Present Christ, pray, and visit classrooms. Encourage students to come to Christ.
- Create programs to enhance spiritual goals in school-wide events, programs, and activities.
- Other duties assigned by the Administration.
